- (a) & (b):Yes, Madam. Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)'s two institutions, Sugarcane Breeding Institute, Coimbatore and Indian Institute of Sugarcane Research, Lucknow are conducting basic and applied research. These institutions have developed a number of improved technologies viz., 114 varieties, production and protection technologies and improved machinery to enhance the production and productivity of sugarcane. With the use of these technologies, sugarcane production has increased from 692 lakh tons to 3593 lakh tons and productivity from 40.55 t/ha to 69.85 t/ha from 1950-51 to 2014-15, respectively.
- (c) & (d):The new technologies developed by ICAR and other institutions are successfully transferred to the farmers through various means such as field demonstrations, Kisan Mela/Exhibitions, distribution of quality seed and new methods of planting at Technology park in institutions for visiting farmers.
