

Govt to set up bio-ethanol project

CHANDIGARH, JULY 9

To curb stubble-burning and create a positive atmosphere for industrialisation, the state government has taken a decision to set up a bio-ethanol project.

A memorandum of understanding (MoU) was signed between the Punjab Government and SAB Industries Ltd with proposed investment of Rs 719 crore on Monday. State Industry and Commerce Minister Sunder Sham Arora said this project would produce 25,000 TPA 2G bio-ethanol from paddy straw in Punjab which would not only generate investment and employment, but also help reduce stubble-burning. — TNS
