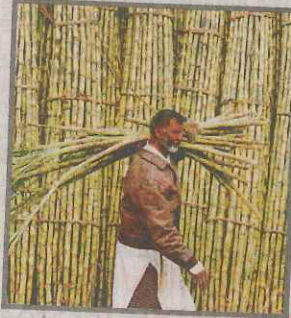


Sugar Output has Fallen 30%, says Isma

India's sugar production has fallen sharply by 30.22% in the first three months of current marketing year ending September, but ex-mill prices have remained stable so far, helping mills clear cane payment to farmers on time, Isma said on Thursday.
