

DFS Secy Sanjay Malhotra is new Revenue Secretary, Manoj Govil gets Corporate Affairs

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Sanjay Malhotra will take over as Revenue Secretary from December 1 while Manoj Govil will take charge as Corporate Affairs Secretary immediately. Both of them are part of the 16 new Secretary-level appointments made on Wednesday.

Malhotra, a 1990 batch IAS officer of Rajasthan cadre and the current Financial Services Secretary, will replace Tarun Bajaj who is superannuating on November 30. Vivek Joshi will come in place of Malhotra in the Financial Services

Department. Joshi, a 1989 batch officer of Haryana cadre, is currently working as the Registrar General of India and Census Commissioner, Ministry of Home Affairs.

Manoj Govil is a 1991

batch officer of Madhya Pradesh cadre. He is at present in the State.

OTHER APPOINTMENTS

Aramane Giridhar, a 1988 batch officer of Andhra Pradesh cadre, will move from the Road Ministry to Defence Ministry first as Officer on Special Duty (OSD) and then as Secretary after retirement of the present Secretary Ajay Kumar on October 31. Giridhar will be replaced by Alka Upadhyaya, a 1990 batch officer of Madhya Pradesh cadre, presently the NHAI Chairperson.

Nagendra Nath Sinha, a 1987 batch officer of Jharkhand cadre, will move

to the Steel Ministry from Rural Development Ministry, replacing incumbent Sanjay Kumar Singh with effect from January 1, 2023.
