SHRI THAWAR CHAND GAHLOT

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state :-

(a) the States that have demanded wheat, rice, sugar, oil etc. from Government for their BPL families during the last three years, the number of such families in each State and the details of the amount of each of the above mentioned items demanded, State-wise and year-wise;

(b) the details of the quantum of food items provided by Government, year-wise and State-wise; and

(c) whether some States are implementing the schemes under which they provide wheat at the rate of two rupees per kilo and rice at the rate of three rupees per kilo to poor families for which they have made additional demands of wheat and rice from the centre?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (PROF. K.V. THOMAS)

(a) to (c) : The commodity-wise details are as under:

FOODGRAINS:

Under the Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS), allocation of foodgrains to States/Union Territories (UTs) is made on the basis of 1993-94 poverty estimates of Planning Commission and March 2000 population estimates of Registrar General of India. As per these estimates, Government is making allocation of foodgrains for all accepted number of 6.52 crore Below Poverty Line (BPL) families, including 2.43 crore Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) families in the country @ 35 kg. per family per month. The allocation of foodgrains (wheat and rice) are made to the BPL and AAY families at the following Central Issue Prices (CIP):

Wheat	4.15	2.00

The state-wise details of the accepted number of BPL families & allocation of foodgrains made during the last 3 three years are at Annexure I, II & III.

Requests have been received from States/UTs for higher allocation for BPL families. Considering the availability of surplus stocks in the Central Pool and the requests received from the States/UTs for higher allocation, Government has been making additional allocation of foodgrains over and above the normal allocation under Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) to the BPL families from time to time as per details given in the Annexure II & III.

LEVY SUGAR: In February, 2001, the Central Government, in a move toward better targeting of Public Distribution System (PDS), has restricted the supply of levy sugar under the PDS to Below Poverty Line (BPL) families except in the North Eastern States, Hill States and Island Territories where universal coverage was allowed to continue. The allocation of levy sugar is made by the Central Government to the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations as per their fixed monthly levy sugar quota. A statement showing details of total No. of projected BPL households as on 1.3.2000, average size of BPL households as per 1991 census, total BPL population, sugar distribution norms per person per month and monthly levy sugar requirement in respect of State Governments/Union Territories Administrations and the allocation of levy sugar during 2008-09, 2009-10 and current 2010-2011 sugar seasons (October–September) are as per Annex-IV-V.

VANASPATI OIL: In order to provide relief to consumers especially BPL households, since 2008, a scheme for distribution of subsidized imported edible oils through States/UTs has been implemented by Government for distribution of edible oils to ration card holders with a Central subsidy of Rs. 15/- per kg. The scheme was extended in 2009-10, 2010-11 and 2011-12 (upto 30.9.2012). The State Governments/UTs are allocated edible oils as per their demand. State-wise details of the edible oils allocated during the last three years are as per Annex-VI.
